**ROUTINE “WELL CHILD” APPOINTMENT SCHEDULE (P.E., Physical Exam & D.A., Developmental Assessment). AAP and CDC Vaccine Recommendation.**

<b>BIRTH</b>	Hep B
<b>1 MONTH</b>	Exam Only
<b>2 MONTHS</b>	Vaxelis (DTaP, IPV, HIB, Hep B), Pneumococcal, Rotavirus
<b>4 MONTHS</b>	Vaxelis (DTaP, IPV, HIB, Hep B), Pneumococcal, Rotavirus
<b>6 MONTHS</b>	Vaxelis (DTaP, IPV, HIB, Hep B), Pneumococcal, Rotavirus
<b>9 MONTHS</b>	Exam Only
<b>12 MONTHS</b>	Hep A #1, Pneumococcal, MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella), Hemoglobin Lead Level, PPD, if necessary
<b>15 MONTHS</b>	Varicella, Pentacel (DTaP, IPV, HIB)
<b>18 MONTHS</b>	Hep A #2
<b>4 YEARS</b>	Quadracel (DTaP, IPV), ProQuad (MMR and Varicella)
<b>11 YEARS</b>	Tdap, Menquadfi #1 (Meningococcal), HPV9, Lipid
<b>12-15 YEARS</b>	HPV9 Series (If not started and/or completed)
<b>16 YEARS</b>	Menquadfi #2 (Meningococcal), HPV9 (If not started and/or completed), Lipid
<b>17-18 YEARS</b>	Trumenba (Men B) Series, HPV9 (If not started and/or completed)
<b>2 YEARS &amp; OVER</b>	Physical exams yearly

### **STATE OF ILLINOIS REQUIRES SCHOOL PHYSICALS FOR CHILDREN ENTERING:**

<b>KINDERGARTEN</b>	<b>Exam, Immunizations done at 4 years old</b>
<b>6<sup>th</sup> GRADE</b>	<b>Exam, Tdap, Menquadfi (Meningococcal), HPV9 series</b>
<b>9<sup>th</sup> GRADE</b>	<b>Exam, HPV9 series</b>

Influenza Vaccine- highly recommended for children 6 months of age and older (August through April)

Please note: We are able to give DTaP, IPV, HIB, Hep B, MMR and Varicella not as a combo vaccine. However, we cannot separate the components of DTaP into diphtheria, tetanus and pertussis or MMR into measles, mumps and rubella.

## **IMMUNIZATIONS**

<b>DTaP</b>	Diphtheria/tetanus/acellular pertussis
<b>Tdap</b>	Tetanus/diphtheria/acellular pertussis
<b>HIB</b>	Haemophilus influenza type B
<b>IPV</b>	Inactivated polio
<b>MMR</b>	Measles/mumps/rubella
<b>HBV</b>	Hepatitis B vaccine
<b>PCV</b>	Pneumococcal Conjugate vaccine (Prevnar 20)
<b>HAV</b>	Hepatitis A vaccine
<b>MCV</b>	Meningococcal vaccine (Menquadfi)
<b>PRV</b>	Rotavirus vaccine (Rotateq)
<b>HPV</b>	Human Papillomavirus vaccine (Gardasil)
<b>Varicella</b>	ChickenPox vaccine (Varivax)
<b>Men B</b>	Meningococcal B vaccine (Trumenba)
